A small collection (c. twenty-five) items detailing one man's Conscientious Objector status during the Second World War, including his handwritten statement and several appeal documents. Alec

Maxted of Leyton first claims exemption from 'any prosecution of the war' in April 1940, he is then called to appear before the Local Tribunal to be registered in the Register of Conscientious Objectors on the 30 August 1940. He is seemingly granted exemption from combatant duties, but not non-combatant duties. He first appeals against this decision on the 10th of September 1940, his grounds being that 'in accepting this I would be part of the military machine which accepts killing as its basic principle ... as the Local Tribunal was satisfied at the conscientiousness of my objection to combatant duties it is only logical in my opinion that I cannot help in non-combatant duties'. He is called up for non-combatant duties. Appealing against this decision in February of 1941, Maxted states, 'I am not at war and am not prepared to take part in the wholesale slaughter'. He appears before the Appellate Tribunal on the 28th February 1941, the decision being that he is conditionally registered in the Register of Conscientious Objectors but must undertake full time ARP, AFS or Land Work. He is finally released from his National Service in June 1946. Also included is a well read copy of a pamphlet called 'The C.O. and the Tribunal' **£75.00**




