




The following books are nearly all from the library of Robin Langdon-Davies, (those that are not are marked with an asterisk), one of the sons of John Langdon-Davies, the author and journalist, particularly well known for his coverage of the Spanish Civil War.

John returned to Spain in 1936 to cover the civil war for the *News Chronicle* and was accompanied on this trip by Robin. John's resulting book 'Behind the Spanish Barricades' (see item 30), was published to critical acclaim in November 1936. Robin's recollections of this trip were recorded by the Imperial War Museum in 1991


Robin was an RAF pilot in WWII and was later heavily involved with Oxfam.




