Map of London and its environs, printed on calico in sepia, approximately 890mm x 880mm in size, no place but probably London. Slightly creased from old folds and to edges, a couple of spots of light foxing and minor browning, but generally quite bright and clean. With the royal arms of William IV to the top right corner, the second state dated 1832 (an earlier one was issued in 1831). The same handkerchief made £3750 (hammer) in the Lennox-Boyd sale at Christies in 2008. See Howgego 328a (2) £2,500.00

Colour printed handkerchief, no date, but probably 1919, approximately 630mm x 490mm in size. Slightly creased but quite bright and clean. A 'souvenir of the Great War', with central image of the peace treaty surrounded by twenty-eight portraits of the principal actors from the Allied side including Winston Churchill **£150.00**

Produced by the Daily Mail to help support dependants of soldiers fighting in the Boer War. A later handkerchief with a different design, which was issued for the same purpose, but printed in blue only, with music written by Sir Arthur Sullivan to accompany the poem, is well known (see item 26) £250.00

Showing Gladstone dealing with his 'inheritance' from Disraeli, including having to send troops against Arabi Pasha to protect British interests in the Suez Canal £750.00

Very slightly creased, one or two spots of foxing, very minor browning to edges, generally fairly clean. Presumably showing the Middle Eastern Theatre of World War One £150.00

An interesting advertising map for a drapers in Towyn-On-Sea (Wales), where this map, as well as tourist information - "information given to visitors concerning the District, how to see, climb its rugged mountains, and enjoy its scenery" - was freely available £100.00

Now the Manchester Central Library, it was loosely designed on the Pantheon in Rome, with the foundation stone laid by Ramsay MacDonald £45.00

Now the Manchester Central Library, it was loosely designed on the Pantheon in Rome, with the foundation stone laid by Ramsay MacDonald £75.00

Good+. Blue printed handkerchief on cotton, approximately 480mm x 490mm in size, n.d. c.1901. Slightly creased, a couple of small spots of foxing, but generally fairly clean. With portraits of Lord Roberts and Queen Victoria, a map of South Africa, the poem by Kipling and the music to accompany the poem by Arthur Sullivan. It was published by the Daily Mail to benefit the dependants of soldiers fighting in the Boer War and was very successful, raising over £250,000. Schoeser, Printed Handkerchiefs, No. 30 £100.00



Two sepia printed handkerchiefs, still joined, on cotton, approximately 765mm x 370mm in size, presumably part of a larger sheet which was then cut into individual handkerchiefs, n.d. ?late 19th century. Some light foxing, edges slightly unevenly cut with minor fraying, small 'D' in



pencil to bottom left hand corner, but generally quite bright. The Greenwich hospital handkerchief has an attractive central vignette, with a brief history of the Hospital, the other showing Daniel in the Lion's Den surrounded by a poem telling the story £95.00

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
