bright and clean. Each volume is signed by Kenny to title, and each also has a dedication or note by Kenny to half-title. The first volume also has a short note by Kenny laid in. A photocopy of an article from *The Times* criticising the lack of female philosophers in the books is laid in to the fourth volume. Noted as "magisterial ... [a] grand survey, written with luminous clarity, [it] was more concise and analytically powerful than Coplestone's celebrated *History of Philosophy*, and greatly surpassed Russell's best-selling *History of Western Philosophy* in scholarship, accuracy, and judgement. It combined historical and biographical survey with methodical philosophical overviews of developments in logic, metaphysics, epistemology, philosophy of mind, ethics, and political thought.
